- 2. Agenda Item 2 LEPS Fund Report was provided by Staff. Motion made, Sheriff Coffman seconded Mayor Barrett. The motion was approved unanimously without any discussion and no negative votes cast.
- 3. Agenda Item 3 Consideration of applications for in-service training programs A) Annual In-Service Courses, B) Combined In-Service Courses, and C) Supervisory In-Service Courses, motion made, Sheriff Coffman seconded, Ms. Welch to approve all categories and courses.
