- A1: Yes
- Q2: 1.04.B.5 Performance Requirements, Preventative Maintenance Disinfection is required at variable timeframes "from disinfection date". Can clarification be provided on what constitutes the "disinfection date"?
- A2: As per the requirements stated in the operation and maintenance manual.
- Q3: 1.04.B.4.d Performance Requirements, Preventative Maintenance 1.04.B.4.d indicates the contractor must wire-brush and paint all rusted metal annually. What are the limitations for this requirement? Ex. Within the perimeter fence, exposed surfaces of the SBR tank, within the control room, etc.
- A3: Area within the perimeter security fence that is installed around the new wastewater treatment plant equipment.
